CHAPTER 13

TOWN GARDENS PROTECTION ACT 1863

- 1 Gardens in Squares, &c. of Fifty Years Standing may be freed from Neglect, Encroachments, &c., and vested in the Metropolitan Board of Works or other Corporate Authority ; or vested in a Committee of rated Inhabitants.
- 2 Protection of open Spaces from Encroachment.
- 3 Expenses how to be defrayed.
- 4 Byelaws for Management of Garden, &c.
- 5 Penalty for injuring Garden.
- 6 Certain Provisions of 18 & 19 Vict. c. 120. to be incorporated with this Act, and to apply to Penalties, &c. imposed by this Act.
- 7 Act not to extend to Property of the Crown or to Property under the Management of the Commissioners of Works, &c.
- 8 Extent of Act.
