



Duchy of Cornwall Management Act 1863

6 Remedy for Recovery of annual Sums. Power to release a Portion of the Lands chargeable.

Where the Consideration for any such Sale, Disposal, or Enfranchisement shall consist either wholly or in part of an annual Sum of Money, either perpetual or to continue for a limited Period only, the Duke of *Cornwall* shall and may have and exercise all such Powers and Remedies for the recovering and obtaining Payment of every such annual Sum as such Duke of *Cornwall* might have and exercise if such annual Sum were a Rent Service reserved on a Demise or Lease made by the Duke of *Cornwall* of the Possessions out of or in respect of which such annual Sum shall be reserved or made payable; and the Duke of *Cornwall*, on the Repurchase or Redemption of any such annual Sum or any Part thereof, may, by Deed under the Seal of the Duchy of *Cornwall*, release the whole, or, in the Case of a partial Repurchase or Redemption, a proportionate or other Part of the Land or Hereditaments chargeable therewith, from all future Payments of such annual Sum, or Part thereof, as the Case may be, and from all Claims and Demands in respect thereof.
