II.—PROCEDURE IN PRIZE CAUSES

Goods

31 Application of foregoing provisions to prize goods.

The foregoing provisions relating to ships [^{F1}and aircraft] shall extend and apply, mutatis mutandis, to goods taken as prize on board ship [^{F1}or aircraft]; and the court may direct such goods to be unladen, inventoried, and warehoused.
