Miscellaneous

59 Protection of Admiralty.

The Admiralty shall not, by reason of anything done or omitted to be done in the execution or intended execution of this Act, or in relation to any lands vested in the Admiralty by virtue of this Act or purchased by the Admiralty under this Act, be liable collectively or individually to any fine, penalty, or forfeiture, or to the execution of any process against person or property.
