

# Metropolitan Fire Brigade Act 1865

### 1865 CHAPTER 90 28 and 29 Vict

#### Expenses

## 17 Examination of books of insurance companies.

The secretary or other officer having the custody of the books and papers of any insurance company that is required to pay a contribution to the [FIGreater London Council] in pursuance of this Act shall allow any officer appointed by the [FIGreater London Council] to inspect, during the hours of business, any books and papers that will enable him to ascertain the amount of property insured by such company in [FIGreater London other than the Outer London boroughs], and the amount for which it is insured, and to make extracts from such books or papers; and any secretary or other such officer as aforesaid of a company failing to comply with the requisitions of this section in respect of such inspections and extracts shall be liable on summary conviction to a penalty not exceeding [F2]evel 1 on the standard scale] for each offence.
