LXXXV Orders need only refer to Act.

And be it enacted, That in any Order made by Her Majesty in Council under the Authority of this Act or of the first-recited Act it shall be sufficient to refer to the Act under the Authority whereof the Order is made, and it shall not be necessary to recite any of the Provisions of this Act or of the said first-recited Act.
