1868 CHAPTER 96 31 and 32 Vict

## 4 Appeal, how to be taken.

An appeal under this Act shall be taken by the appellant or his agent presenting a summary petition to the sheriff  $\dots$  <sup>F1</sup>, praying him to stay the proceedings before the presbytery, and to dispose of the same himself:  $\dots$  <sup>F1</sup>
