4 Transfer of invalids to naval hospital, &c.

The Admiralty may, under regulations to be from time to time made by them, send any non-commissioned officers or men admitted to the benefits of Greenwich Hospital to a . . . ^{F1} hospital or infirmary, to be there maintained at the expense of Greenwich Hospital.
