



# Pensions Commutation Act 1871

1871 CHAPTER 36 34 and 35 Vict

## 7 †Power to Treasury to make regulations.

Subject to the provisions of this Act, [<sup>F1</sup>the Minister for the Civil Service] may from time to time make, alter, or revoke regulations as to the following matters:—

- (1) The rules according to which applications for commutation are to be made or, . . . <sup>F2</sup> withdrawn:
- (2) The tables according to which the duration of life of applicants for commutation is to be calculated for the purposes of this Act:
- (3) The terms upon which pensions are to be commuted, and the cases in which commutation is to be refused.
