

# Evidence Further Amendment (Scotland) Act 1874

### 1874 CHAPTER 64 37 and 38 Vict

## 5 Interpretation of terms. U.K.

In this Act the term "sheriff" includes sheriff substitute, and any person appointed by a sheriff to take evidence on commission according to the present law and practice.
