1874 CHAPTER 81 37 and 38 Vict

8 Duties and salary of clerk of the Crown.

It shall continue to be lawful for Her Majesty from time to time under Her Royal Sign Manual to appoint a fit person to fill the office of clerk of the Crown in Chancery.

The clerk of the Crown in Chancery shall continue to perform the duties of the office of keeper or clerk of the hanaper, \dots ^{F1}

There shall be paid to any person appointed \dots ^{F2} to be clerk of the Crown in Chancery such salary as the Treasury may assign to him.

The salaries of the clerk of the Crown in Chancery, and of his officers, and the expenses of his office, shall be paid out of moneys provided by Parliament.
