



Conveyancing (Scotland) Act 1874

1874 CHAPTER 94 37 and 38 Vict

59 Act shall apply to lands held of the Crown and Prince.

The provisions of this Act [^{F1}shall apply to lands held of the Crown and of the Prince, in the same way as to lands held of a subject superior, but]shall not prejudice or affect the jus coronæ as a title to lands or heritages.
