## Exemptions and Savings

## 98 Saving for rocket and fog stations.

This Act shall not apply-

- (1) To the keeping of any rockets for use in any apparatus for saving life, kept under the control of the [<sup>F1</sup>Secretary of State] or the Board of Trade; or
- (2) To the keeping of any explosive kept for the purpose of signalling at or near a station on the sea coast, under the control of any general lighthouse authority, as defined by the [<sup>F2M1</sup>Merchant Shipping Act 1894].
