



# Public Stores Act 1875

1875 CHAPTER 25 38 and 39 Vict

## 13 Provision for regimental necessaries, &c.

The provisions of this Act relative to the taking out, destroying, or obliterating of marks, [<sup>F1</sup>or to the having in possession or keeping Her Majesty's stores], shall not apply to stores issued as regimental necessaries or otherwise for any soldier, <sup>F2</sup>. . . or volunteer; but nothing herein shall relieve any person from any obligation or liability to which he may be subject under any other Act in respect of any such stores.
