1841 CHAPTER 30 4 and 5 Vict

3 **Sheriffs in Scotland to settle the amount of compensation.**

The amount of the damages for which compensation is provided under this Act shall, in Scotland, be ascertained and determined by the [^{F1}sheriff principal of the sheriffdom], whose decision in the matter shall be final and conclusive, and not subject to review, by suspension, advocacy, reduction, or otherwise.
