

Ordnance Survey Act 1841

1841 CHAPTER 30 4 and 5 Vict

3 Sheriffs in Scotland to settle the amount of compensation.

The amount of the damages for which compensation is provided under this Act shall, in Scotland, be ascertained and determined by the [^{F1}sheriff principal of the sheriffdom], whose decision in the matter shall be final and conclusive, and not subject to review, by suspension, advocation, reduction, or otherwise.
