



Conveyancing and Law of Property Act 1881

1881 CHAPTER 41

An Act for simplifying and improving the practice of Conveyancing; and for vesting in Trustees, Mortgagees, and other various powers commonly conferred by provisions inserted in Settlements, Mortgages, Wills, and other Instruments; and for amending in various particulars the Law of Property ; and for other purposes. [22nd August 1881]

BE it enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:
