CUSTOMS AND EXCISE

4 Alteration of date of expiration of certain game licences.

Every licence or certificate to kill game now in force, or to be taken out under the ^{MI}Game Licences Act, 1860, which expires, or would expire, under the provisions of that Act on the fifth day of April, shall expire on the thirty-first day of July, and wherever in such provisions the fifth day of April is mentioned or referred to, the same shall be read as if the thirty-first day of July had been therein inserted in lieu of the said fifth day of April.
