1887 CHAPTER 52

3 Exceptions.

Nothing in this Act shall affect the powers and duties of the said Secretary of State under or in pursuance of the Acts of Parliament herein-after mentioned or any Acts amending the same, viz.:—

- (a) The Factory and Workshop Act, 1878.
- (b) The Coal Mines Regulation Act, 1872.
- (c) The Metalliferous Mines Regulation Act, 1872.
- (d) The Explosives Act, 1875.
- (e) The Cruelty to Animals Act, 1876.
- (f) The Reformatory and Industrial Schools Acts, 1866-1879.
