In this Act unless the context otherwise requires—
[F1The expression "county", in relation to England, means, subject to the provisions of Schedule 2A to this Act, a county for the purposes of the Local Government Act 1972;]

The expression "writ" includes any process.
^{F4} Any reference to a justice of the peace for a county shall be construed in relation to any area in England [F5 and Wales] outside Greater London as a reference to a justice of the peace for a commission area [F6 (within the meaning of the Justices of the Peace Act 1997)] comprising the whole or any part of that county.]
