CHAPTER 98

SLAVE TRADE ACT 1843

The recited Act and this Act shall apply to all British Subjects where-
ever residing.

- II What Persons are designated by the Term Slaves.
- III Trial of Offenders against the recited Act and this Act.
- IV Evidence may be taken abroad, and transmitted to the Court of Queen's Bench.
- V In Cases not prohibited hereby Slaves may be sold or transferred.
- VI Act not to extend to Persons obtaining Slaves by Inheritance, &c.
- VII Commencement of Act.
