RATING AND BORROWING POWERS.

Assessments.

135 General assessments in districts other than burghs.

With respect to districts other than burghs, all charges and expenses incurred by or devolving on the local authority in executing this Act or any of the Acts hereby repealed, and not recovered as herein-before provided, may be defrayed out of an assesment (in this Act referred to as the public health general assesment) to be levied by the local authority upon all lands and heritages within the district or in the case of counties not divided into districts within the county, in the like manner as, but as a separate assesment from, the assesment herein-after mentioned in this section; that is to say, the said assesment shall be assesmed, levied, and recovered in like manner and under like powers as—

The assesment for the maintenance of roads under the provisions of the Roads and Bridges (Scotland) Act, 1878, or, where there is no such assesment, by an assesment levied in like manner as an assesment might have been levied for the maintenance of roads under that Act.

Nothing contained in this Act shall affect or prejudice the provisions of the Agricultural Rates, Congested Districts and Burgh Land Tax Relief (Scotland) Act, 1896.
