Enforcement of and Procedure under Act

168 Exemption from stamp duties.

All bonds, assignments, conveyances, instruments, agreements, . . . ^{F1}, or other writings made or granted by or to or in favour of the local authority [^{F2}for the purposes of this Act] shall be exempt from all stamp duties.
