XCI Costs of Partition.

And be it enacted, That all Costs and Expenses attending any Partition to be made by virtue of this Act shall be borne and defrayed by the several Proprietors of or Persons interested in the Estates which shall be so parted in such Manner and Proportions as the Valuer shall order, and in case of Nonpayment thereof shall be recovered in the Manner directed with respect to the Recovery of Penalties and Forfeitures.
