CHAPTER 100

TITHE ACT 1832

- What Prescriptions and Claims of Modus decimandi to be valid in Law.
Proviso.
- II What Compositions for Tithes shall be considered valid.
 - III The Act not available in any Suit now commenced, &c.
 - IV To what Cases this Act shall not extend.
 - V Time during which Lands shall be held by Persons entitled to the Tithes thereof to be excluded in the Computation under this Act ;
 - VI as also the Time during which any Person capable of resisting any Claim shall be an Infant, &c.
 - VII What it shall be sufficient to allege in Actions commenced under this Act.
 - VIII No Presumption allowed in support of any Claim for any less Period than mentioned in this Act.
 - IX Act to extend to England only.
