Provided always, and be it further enacted, That nothing in this Act contained shall extend to alter or in any Manner affect the. Provisions of an Act passed in the First Year of the Reign of His, late Majesty King *George* the Fourth, intituled *An Act for regulating the Repairs of Bridges in the County of* Montgomery, so far as the same relates to the Repairs of so much of the Highways as lie next adjoining to any Ends of any Bridges within the said County of Montgomery, the Repairs of which have already been made chargeable upon the Rates of the said County under the Provisions of the said recited Act.
