1837 CHAPTER 26 7 Will 4 and 1 Vict

16 Creditor attesting to be admitted a witness.

In case by any will any real or personal estate shall be charged with any debt or debts, and any creditor, or the wife or husband^{F1} or civil partner] of any creditor, whose debt is so charged, shall attest the execution of such will, such creditor notwithstanding such charge shall be admitted a witness to prove the execution of such will, or to prove the validity or invalidity thereof.
