

THE AGRICULTURE ACT, 1947 (COMMENCEMENT) (NO. 2)
ORDER, 1948.

Made - - - 11th March, 1948

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 11th day of March, 1948.

PRESENT,

The King's Most Excellent Majesty in Council.

Whereas by subsection (2) of section 111 of the Agriculture Act, 1947, 10 & 11 Geo. 6. c. 48. it is provided that that Act shall come into operation on such date as His Majesty may by Order in Council appoint, and that an Order under that subsection may appoint different dates in relation to different provisions of the said Act :

And whereas by virtue of the Agriculture Act, 1947 (Commencement) Order, 1947,(a) and the Agriculture Act, 1947 (Commencement) (No. 1) Order, 1948,(b) the provisions of the said Act specified in the said Orders came into operation on the respective dates thereby appointed :

And whereas it is expedient that the further provisions of the said Act hereinafter specified should come into operation on the date hereinafter appointed :

Now, therefore, His Majesty is pleased by and with the advice of His Privy Council to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows :—

1. Sections one to eight of the said Act and the First Schedule thereto shall come into operation on the thirty-first day of March, 1948.

2. This Order may be cited as the Agriculture Act, 1947 (Commencement) (No. 2) Order, 1948.
