The Import of Goods (Control) Order 1954

Interpretation and revocation

6.—(1) In this Order “goods”, unless otherwise specified, means both used and unused goods.

(2) The Interpretation Act, 1889, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament and as if this Order and the Orders hereby revoked were Acts of Parliament.

7. The Import of Goods (Control) Order, 1940(1), the Import of Goods (Control) Order, 1945(2), the Import of Goods (Control) (No. 2) Order, 1945(3), and the Import of Goods (Control) (Amendment) Order, 1952(4), are hereby revoked.
