The Republic of Cyprus Order in Council, 1960

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 3rd day of August, 1960

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Her Majesty, by virtue and in exercise of the powers conferred on Her by section 1 of the Cyprus Act, 1960(a), or otherwise in Her vested, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Republic of Cyprus Order in Council, 1960, and shall come into operation on the 10th day of August, 1960.

Designation and commencement of the Constitution of the Republic of Cyprus

2. The constitution set out in the documents in the Greek and Turkish languages which were initialled at Ankara on the 28th day of July, 1960, by representatives of Her Majesty's Government in the United Kingdom, the Kingdom of Greece, the Republic of Turkey, the Greek-Cypriot community and the Turkish-Cypriot community as, respectively, the Greek and Turkish texts of the Constitution of the Republic of Cyprus shall be that Constitution and shall come into force on the 16th day of August, 1960.
