**The Visiting Forces Act (Application
to the Isle of Man) Order 1962**

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Visiting Forces Act (Application to the Isle of Man) Order, 1962, and shall come into operation on the first day of March, 1962.

(2) The Interpretation Act, 1889, shall apply for the purpose of interpreting this Order as it applies for the purpose of interpreting an Act of Parliament.

2. The provisions of the Act as subsequently amended, other than section fifteen thereof, shall extend to the Isle of Man subject to the adaptations, modifications and exceptions specified in the Schedule to this Order.

3. The Visiting Forces (Designation) Order, 1954⁽¹⁾ (which designates Belgium, France, the Netherlands, Norway and the United States of America for the purposes of all the provisions of the Act following subsection (2) of section one thereof), the Visiting Forces (Designation) Order, 1956⁽²⁾ (which designates Luxembourg, Turkey, Greece, Denmark, Portugal and Italy for the same purposes), and the Visiting Forces (Designation) Order, 1961⁽³⁾ (which designates the Federal Republic of Germany for the same purposes), shall extend to the Isle of Man.
