EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order brings into force on 12th September 1966 the provisions of section 2 of the Finance Act 1966 for the payment of relief in respect of certain taxes incurred in connection with the construction and fitting out of certain ships and floating structures.
