# The Development Areas Order 1966

Made - - - 12th August 1966
Laid before Parliament 17th August 1966
Coming into Operation 19th August 1966

The Board of Trade, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 15 of the Industrial Development Act 1966(a), hereby make the following Order:—

- 1. The areas described in the Schedule to this Order are hereby specified as development areas for the purposes of the Local Employment Act 1960(b).
- 2.—(1) The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- (2) This Order may be cited as the Development Areas Order 1966 and shall come into operation on 19th August 1966.
