The Training of Teachers (Local Education Authorities) Amending Regulations 1966

Made--25th August 1966Laid before Parliament31st August 1966Coming into Operation1st September 1966

The Secretary of State for Education and Science, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 3(4) of the Local Government Act 1958(a), hereby makes the following regulations:—

Citation, commencement and interpretation

- 1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Training of Teachers (Local Education Authorities) Amending Regulations 1966 and shall come into operation on 1st September 1966.
- (2) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply for the interpretation of these regulations as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Amendment of regulations

- 2. The Training of Teachers (Local Education Authorities) Regulations 1959(c) as amended (d) shall have effect subject to the following amendments:—
 - (a) in regulation 10(1) (which provides for full-time courses of initial training), the expression "full-time" shall be omitted and after the word "courses"; there shall be inserted the words "which may include part-time courses";
 - (b) at the end of regulation 11 (which provides for the duration of courses of initial training) there shall be added the following paragraph—

 "(3) This regulation does not apply to part-time courses."; and
 - (c) in regulation 14(4) (which makes provision with regard to the qualifications for admission to an art training centre), for the word "General" there shall be substituted the word "a".
- 3.—(1) The principal regulations, except regulation 7, shall apply to departments of education in establishments of further education as they apply to training colleges.
- (2) In this regulation the expression "the principal regulations" means the Training of Teachers (Local Education Authorities) Regulations 1959 as amended by any enactment, including these regulations; and "department of education" means a department for the initial training of teachers.
