**The Swaziland (Benefits under Retirement Scheme)  
Order 1966**

*Made - - - - - 20th September 1966*

*Laid before Parliament 26th September 1966*

*Coming into Operation 27th September 1966*

At the Court at Balmoral, the 20th day of September 1966

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Her Majesty, by virtue and in exercise of the powers in that behalf by the Foreign Jurisdiction Act 1890(a) or otherwise in Her Majesty vested, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows :—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Swaziland (Benefits under Retirement Scheme) Order 1966.

(2) This Order shall be published in the Swaziland Government Gazette and shall come into operation on 27th September 1966.

Interpre-  
tation.

2.—(1) In this Order—

“High Commissioner” means the holder of the former office of High Commissioner for Basutoland, the Bechuanaland Protectorate and Swaziland ;

“payment” means any payment of pension, gratuity or other allowance in respect of public service under the Government of Swaziland ;

“public service under the Government of Swaziland” means the service of a person as the holder of an office specified in the Schedule to this Order in so far as his salary and, as the case may be, his emoluments were drawn from the funds of Swaziland.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply, with the necessary adaptations, for the purpose of interpreting this Order and otherwise in relation thereto as it applies for the purpose of interpreting, and in relation to, Acts of the Parliament of the United Kingdom.

3. Nothing in the Pensions Proclamation(c) as is in force in Swaziland on the date of the commencement of this Order shall affect the validity of any thing done or payment made before that date in respect of or to a person, who was on 31st July 1964 the holder of an office specified in the Schedule to this Order, under the terms of a scheme

of retirement (whether contained in a law or not) which is applicable to that person in respect of public service under the Government of Swaziland; and such scheme of retirement, in so far as it relates to payments to be made thereunder to or in respect of that person on or after the date of the commencement of this Order, shall continue to have full force and effect according to the terms of the scheme.
