## The Matrimonial Causes (District Registries) Order 1966

*Made* - - - -

13th October 1966

I, Gerald, Baron Gardiner, Lord High Chancellor of Great Britain, in exercise of the power vested in me by Rule 1(3) of the Matrimonial Causes Rules 1957(a) and all other powers enabling me in this behalf, and with the concurrence of Sir Jocelyn Simon, President of the Probate, Divorce and Admiralty Division, do hereby make the following Order:—

1. On and after 1st November 1966, any matrimonial cause or matter may, subject to the provisions of the Matrimonial Causes Rules, 1957, as amended(b) be commenced and prosecuted in the District Registries of the High Court at Kendal, Luton, Scunthorpe, Stafford and Wrexham in addition to the District Registries set out in Appendix I of those Rules.

2. This Order may be cited as the Matrimonial Causes (District Registries) Order 1966.
