Her Majesty, by virtue and in exercise of the powers conferred upon Her by section 5 of the West Indies Act 1962(a), is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

Citation and commencement.

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Barbados Order 1966 and shall come into operation on 18th November 1966.
- Premier to be styled Prime Minister.
- 2. Any person holding the office of Premier established by paragraph 33 of Schedule 2 to the Barbados (Letters Patent Consolidation) Order 1964(b) shall be entitled to the style of Prime Minister.
