CUSTOMS AND EXCISE

The Import Duties (General) (No. 9) Order 1966

Made - - - - 23rd November 1966

*Laid before the House
of Commons - - 29th November 1966*

Coming into Operation - 1st December 1966

The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury, by virtue of the powers conferred on them by sections 1, 2 and 13 of the Import Duties Act 1958(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, on the recommendation of the Board of Trade hereby make the following Order:—

1. In Schedule 1 to the Import Duties (General) (No. 10) Order 1964(b) (which Schedule by reference to the Customs Tariff 1959 sets out the import duties chargeable under the Import Duties Act 1958), in heading 34.02 (organic surface-active agents; surface-active preparations and washing preparations, whether or not containing soap), the following shall be substituted for sub-headings (A) and (B)—

“(A) Products of the condensation of normal aliphatic alcohols containing eight or more carbon atoms in the molecule with epoxyalkanes or alkanediols, and preparations and mixtures containing not less than 90 per cent. by weight of such products	20%	—	—
(B) Other:			
(1) Consisting solely of polyethylene glycol ethers or of polyethylene glycol ether-esters	—	—	—
(2) Other	10%	—	2%”

2.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Import Duties (General) (No. 9) Order 1966.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

(3) This Order shall come into operation on 1st December 1966.
