CUSTOMS AND EXCISE

The Import Duty Drawbacks (No. 11) Order 1966

The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury, by virtue of the powers conferred on them by sections 9 and 13 of, and Schedule 5 to, the Import Duties Act 1958(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, on the recommendation of the Board of Trade hereby make the following Order:—

1.—(1) In Schedule 1 to the Import Duty Drawbacks (No. 6) Order 1966(b) (which relates to the drawbacks to be allowed on the exportation of imported articles or goods incorporating them), in column 2 of the entry relating to heading 42.02 of the Customs Tariff 1959, the following shall be inserted after paragraph (e) (and accordingly, the existing paragraph (f) shall become paragraph (g))—

“(f) for transparent plastic pass-holders which, on exportation, are incorporated in wallets or billfolds;”.

(2) In column 2 of the entries in that Schedule relating to headings 29.01 and 30.03, for “buta-1:2-diene” and “buta-1:3-diene” there shall be substituted respectively “buta-1, 2-diene” and “buta-1, 3-diene”.

2.—(1) In Schedule 2 to the said Order (which relates to the drawbacks to be allowed on the exportation of goods produced or manufactured from imported articles), in paragraph 3 of the entry relating to linseed oil and goods made therewith (mixtures consisting of cobalt linoleate, linseed oil and linseed oil fatty acids), in column 3, for “£1 0s. 10d.” (the rate of drawback per 100kg. of the mixture) there shall be substituted “10s. 3d.”.

(2) In the entries in that Schedule relating to Acetylcarbromal and Carbromal, in column 2, for “*α*-Ethylbutyric acid” there shall be substituted “2-Ethylbutyric acid”; and in the entry relating to shuttlecocks and shuttlecock skirts, in column 2, for “Poly (11-aminoundecoic acid)” there shall be substituted “Poly (11-aminoundecanoic acid)”.

3.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Import Duty Drawbacks (No. 11) Order 1966.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

(3) This Order shall come into operation on 31st December 1966.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order –

- (i) provides for the allowance of drawback of import duty on imported plastic pass-holders when exported incorporated in wallets and billfolds;
- (ii) varies the rate of drawback of import duty allowable on mixtures of linseed oil, linseed fatty acid and cobalt linoleate manufactured from imported linseed oil; and
- (iii) amends the descriptions of certain chemicals for import duty drawback purposes to conform with revised British Standards nomenclature.
