## **PENSIONS**

The Superannuation (the Civil Service and the Federated Superannuation System for Universities) Transfer (Amendment) Rules 1966

Made	20th April 1966
Laid before Parliament	27th April 1966
Coming into Operation	28th April 1966

The Treasury, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sections 2 and 15 of the Superannuation (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1948(a) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Rules:—

- 1. The Superannuation (the Civil Service and the Federated Superannuation System for Universities) Transfer Rules 1953(b) shall be amended as follows:—
  - (a) by inserting in Rule 6(1)(d) thereof, after the words "F.S.S.U. employment", the words "or within such longer period as the Treasury may allow in any particular case":
  - (b) by substituting in Rule 6(1)(b) thereof, for the words "before changing his employment as aforesaid", the words "before or after changing his employment as aforesaid".
- 2. The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply for the interpretation of these Rules as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. These Rules may be cited as the Superannuation (the Civil Service and the Federated Superannuation System for Universities) Transfer (Amendment) Rules 1966, and shall come into operation on 28th April 1966.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Rules.)

These Rules amend the Superannuation (the Civil Service and the Federated Superannuation System for Universities) Transfer Rules 1953 by giving the Treasury discretion to allow a longer period than that specified in the 1953 Rules for a person transferring from the Civil Service to employment pensionable under the Federated Superannuation System for Universities to give notice that he desires the 1953 Rules to apply to him.

The Rules also amend the 1953 Rules, which require a civil servant transferring to employment pensionable under the Federated Superannuation System for Universities to obtain the consent of the Head of his Department beforehand, by enabling him to obtain such consent either before or after so transferring.
