NATIONAL INSURANCE

The National Insurance (Assessment of Graduated Contributions) Amendment Regulations 1966

Made - - - 9th May 1966 Laid before Parliament 16th May 1966 Coming into Operation in accordance with Regulation 1

The Minister of Pensions and National Insurance, in exercise of powers conferred by section 4 of the National Insurance Act 1965(a), as amended by section 1 of the National Insurance Act 1966(b), and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, and in consequence of the said Act of 1966. hereby makes the following regulations :—

Citation, interpretation and commencement

1. These regulations, which may be cited as the National Insurance (Assessment of Graduated Contributions) Amendment Regulations 1966, shall be read as one with the National Insurance (Assessment of Graduated Contributions) Regulations 1960(c), as amended(d), (hereinafter referred to as "the principal regulations"), and shall come into operation on the day appointed under the provisions of section 14(4) of the National Insurance Act 1966 for the coming into operation of section 1 of the said Act.

Amendment of regulation 2 of the principal regulations

2. For regulation 2 of the principal regulations (which relates to equivalent amounts) there shall be substituted the following regulation :---

" Equivalent amounts

2.—(1) The equivalent amounts for the purposes of section 4(1) of the National Insurance Act 1965 (under which in respect of any payment exceeding nine pounds or the equivalent amount for remuneration not paid weekly, the graduated contributions are calculated on certain specified amounts, or on the equivalent amounts for remuneration not paid weekly) shall be determined in accordance with the provisions of this regulation.

(2) The respective equivalent amounts shall be—

- (a) where the graduated contribution period is a week:
 - (i) in the case where the employment is not at the time of the payment a non-participating employment, nine pounds and the amount, up to nine pounds, by which the payment exceeds nine pounds, and the amount, up to twelve pounds, by which the payment exceeds eighteen pounds;
 - (ii) in the case where the employment is at the time of the payment a non-participating employment, nine pounds and the amount, up to twenty-one pounds, by which the payment exceeds nine pounds;

- (b) where the graduated contribution period is a multiple of a week, the amounts calculated by applying sub-paragraph (a) of this paragraph with the substitution for any reference to a sum specified in pounds of a reference to the corresponding multiple of that sum;
- (c) where the graduated contribution period is a month:
 - (i) in the case where the employment is not at the time of the payment a non-participating employment, thirty-nine pounds and the amount, up to thirty-nine pounds, by which the payment exceeds thirty-nine pounds, and the amount, up to fifty-two pounds, by which the payment exceeds seventy-eight pounds;
 - (ii) in the case where the employment is at the time of the payment a non-participating employment, thirty-nine pounds and the amount, up to ninety-one pounds, by which the payment exceeds thirty-nine pounds;
- (d) where the graduated contribution period is a multiple of a month, the amounts calculated by applying sub-paragraph (c) of this paragraph with the substitution for any reference to a sum specified in pounds of a reference to the corresponding multiple of that sum; and
- (e) in any other case, the amounts calculated by applying sub-paragraph (a) of this paragraph with the substitution for any reference to a sum specified in pounds of a reference to one-seventh of that sum multiplied by the number of days in the graduated contribution period in question."

Amendment of regulation 3 of and the Schedule to the principal regulations

3.—(1) Regulation 3 of and the Schedule to the principal regulations (which relate to the calculation of graduated contributions) shall be amended in accordance with the following provisions of this regulation.

(2) In paragraphs (1) and (2) of the said regulation, immediately before the word "Schedule" where it respectively occurs, there shall be inserted the word "appropriate" and at the end of the said regulation there shall be added the following paragraph:—

"(4) In this regulation "appropriate Schedule" means Schedule 1 to these regulations in the case of an employment which is not a nonparticipating employment and means Schedule 2 to these regulations in the case of a non-participating employment."

(3) For the Schedule to the principal regulations there shall be substituted the Schedule 1 and Schedule 2 to these regulations.
