## CUSTOMS AND EXCISE

## The Export of Goods (Control) (Amendment No. 2) Order 1966

Made - - - - - 18th May 1966  
 Coming into Operation 21st May 1966

The Board of Trade, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 1 of the Import, Export and Customs Powers (Defence) Act 1939(a), hereby order as follows:—

1. The Export of Goods (Control) Order 1965(b), as amended(c), shall have effect as if—

(i) for article 2(f)(ii) there were substituted the following:—

“live cattle, sheep and swine and meat fresh, chilled or frozen (including edible offal) of such animals from Northern Ireland to the Republic of Ireland;”;

(ii) to the goods included in Schedule 1, Group 8, there were added the following:—

“Meat, fresh, chilled or frozen (including edible offal) of bovine animals, sheep and swine. . . A”.

2. The Interpretation Act 1889(d), shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. This Order may be cited as the Export of Goods (Control) (Amendment No. 2) Order 1966 and shall come into operation on 21st May 1966.

 EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Order.)*

This Order further amends the Export of Goods (Control) Order 1965. Individual licences will now be required for the export of fresh, chilled or frozen meat of bovine animals, sheep and swine, except from Northern Ireland to the Republic of Ireland.
