The National Health Service (Travelling Allowances, etc.) Regulations 1966

The Minister of Health, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 41 and 54 of, and paragraph 2 of Schedule 1, paragraph 2 of Part IV of Schedule 3, and paragraph 3 of Schedule 5 to, the National Health Service Act 1946(a), as amended by the National Health Service (Amendment) Act 1949(b) and by the Public Authorities (Allowances) Act 1961(c), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:—

1. These regulations may be cited as the National Health Service (Travelling Allowances, etc.) Regulations 1966, and shall come into operation on 1st August 1966.

2. The Interpretation Act 1889(d) applies to the interpretation of these regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. In Part I of the Schedule to the National Health Service (Travelling Allowances, etc.) (No. 2) Regulations 1961(e), as amended(f), (which part prescribes maximum rates of payments to members of National Health Service bodies in respect of loss of earnings or additional expenses, other than travelling or subsistence expenses), for “twenty-five shillings” there shall be substituted “32s. 6d.”, and for “fifty shillings” there shall be substituted “65s. 0d.”.

4. The National Health Service (Travelling Allowances, etc.) Regulations 1962 are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These regulations increase the payments which may be made to members of bodies set up under the National Health Service Act 1946 who suffer loss of earnings or incur additional expenses when performing their duties.
