The Copyright (Gibraltar: Protection of Foreign Broadcasts) Order 1966

Made	28th July 1966
Laid before Parliament	3rd August 1966

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Her Majesty, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon Her by section 31 of the Copyright Act 1956(a) and of all other powers enabling Her in that behalf, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to direct, and it is hereby directed, as follows :---

1. Part II and (so far as relevant thereto) Part III of the Copyright (International Conventions) Order 1964(b) shall extend to Gibraltar subject to the modifications specified in the Schedule hereto.

2. The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. This Order may be cited as the Copyright (Gibraltar: Protection of Foreign Broadcasts) Order 1966 and shall come into operation on 28th October 1966.

SCHEDULE

Modifications to Part II of the Copyright (International Conventions) Order 1964

1. In article 8, the words " other than section 40(3) " shall be omitted.

2. In article 9, the words "other than section 37(4), section 40(3) and Schedule 5" and paragraph (a) shall be omitted.

3. In Schedule 5, to the countries listed in column 1 there shall be added Czechoslovakia, Denmark and Brazil and for the dates listed in column 2, there shall be substituted in each case 28th October 1966.

4. In Schedule 6, France shall be deleted from and Czechoslovakia and Brazil shall be added to the countries listed in column 1 and for the dates listed in column 2, there shall be substituted in each case 28th October 1966.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

The United Kingdom proposes to declare Gibraltar to be a territory to which the International Convention for the Protection of Performers, Producers of Phonograms and Broadcasting Organisations shall extend.

This Order implements the obligations thereby undertaken in respect of foreign broadcasts by extending to Gibraltar those provisions of the Copyright (International Conventions) Order 1964 which protect foreign broadcasts.

The law of Gibraltar already gives performers and producers of phonograms the protection required by the Convention.
