The Workmen's Compensation (Supplementation) Amendment (No. 2) Scheme 1967

Made	11th August 1967
Laid before Parliament	21st August 1967
Coming into Operation	31st October 1967

The Minister of Social Security, with the consent of the Treasury, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 2 of the Industrial Injuries and Diseases (Old Cases) Act 1967(a) and section 3(1)(a) of the National Insurance Act 1967(b) and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf hereby makes, in consequence of the National Insurance Act 1967, the following Scheme:—

Citation, interpretation and commencement

1. This Scheme which may be cited as the Workmen's Compensation (Supplementation) Amendment (No. 2) Scheme 1967 shall be read as one with the Workmen's Compensation (Supplementation) Scheme 1966(c) as amended (d) (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Scheme") and shall come into operation on 31st October 1967.

Amendment of Article 7 of the principal Scheme

2. In paragraph (1) of Article 7 of the principal Scheme (computation of loss of earnings) for the words "the date of the coming into operation of this Scheme" there shall be substituted the words "31st October 1967".

Amendment of Article 10 of the principal Scheme

3. In Article 10 of the principal Scheme (allowances in respect of two or more different injuries or diseases) there shall be made the following amendments:

- (i) in paragraph (1)(a)(iii) for the sum "47s. 6d." there shall be substituted the sum "55s.";
- (ii) in paragraph (2)(b) for the sum "17s. 6d." there shall be substituted the sum "20s.".

Amendment of Schedule 1 to the principal Scheme

4. Schedule 1 to the principal Scheme shall be amended by substituting for the sum "125s. 0d." in the first column thereof the sum "139s. 11d." and by the addition at the end of the first and second columns thereof respectively of the sum "140s. 0d." and "55s. 0d.".

Transitional provision

5. Where a lesser incapacity allowance has been awarded to a person under the principal Scheme before 31st October 1967 and a question arises as to the weekly rate of that allowance payable in consequence of this Scheme, the case shall be reviewed by the Board in the light of the amendments made by this Scheme and the allowance shall continue to be payable at the weekly rate specified in the award until the question shall have been determined in accordance with the provisions of the principal Scheme.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Scheme.)

This Scheme amends the Workmen's Compensation (Supplementation) Scheme 1966 so as to give effect to section 3(1)(a) of the National Insurance Act 1967 by increasing the weekly rate of lesser incapacity allowance payable in certain circumstances.

The Scheme is made in consequence of the Act of 1967 and accordingly by virtue of section 7(3) of and Schedule 7 to that Act no draft of the Scheme has been laid before Parliament.
