Her Majesty, in pursuance of section 10(1) of the Marine, &c., Broadcasting (Offences) Act 1967(a), is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:---

1. The Marine, &c., Broadcasting (Offences) Act 1967 shall extend to the Isle of Man with the exceptions, adaptations and modifications specified in the Schedule to this Order.

2. This Order may be cited as the Marine, &c., Broadcasting (Offences) (Isle of Man) Order 1967 and shall come into operation on 1st September 1967.

SCHEDULE

Exceptions, Adaptations and Modifications in the Extension of the Marine, &c., Broadcasting (Offences) Act 1967 to the Isle of Man

1. The words "Isle of Man" shall be substituted for the words "United Kingdom" in the following places where the latter words occur, that is to say, sections 1(1) (first and third places), 2(1), 4(1)(a) (first and third places), 4(2), 5(1)(a) (first and third places), 5(2), 6(3), 9(1) (in the definitions of "external waters" and "the high seas") and 9(2) (first place).

2. In section 5(6) after the words "Copyright Act 1956" there shall be added the words "as extended to the Isle of Man by the Copyright (Isle of Man) Order 1959(b)".

3.--(1) In section 6(4) "enactment" means an Act of Tynwald.

(2) In section 6(5) the words from "in England" to "in Northern Ireland" and the words "for Northern Ireland" shall be omitted.

(3) Section 6(6) and (8) shall be omitted.

4. In section 9(1) at the end of the definition of "wireless telegraphy" there shall be added the words "as extended to the Isle of Man by the Wireless Telegraphy (Isle of Man) Order 1952(a)".

5. Section 11(2) shall be omitted.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order extends the Marine, &c., Broadcasting (Offences) Act 1967 to the Isle of Man with exceptions, adaptations and modifications.
