VETERINARY SURGEONS

The Veterinary Surgeons Act 1966 (Commencement No. 1) Order
1967

Made - - - 22nd February 1967

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 22nd day of February 1967.

Present

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Whereas it is provided by section 29(3) of the Veterinary Surgeons Act 1966(a) that the said Act shall come into operation on such day as Her Majesty may by Order in Council appoint and that different days may be appointed for different purposes:

And Whereas it is further provided by section 29(4) of the said Act that any Order under section 29 thereof may make such transitional provision as appears to Her Majesty to be necessary or expedient in connection with the provisions thereby brought into force, including adaptations of the said Act or of the provisions of any enactment repealed by the said Act.

Now, therefore, Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred on Her by the said section 29, and of all other powers enabling Her in that behalf, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Veterinary Surgeons Act 1966 (Commencement No. 1) Order 1967.

2. Subject to the provision of Article 3 of this Order, the provisions of the Veterinary Surgeons Act 1966 (except section 28(1) so far as it relates to the Veterinary Surgeons (Irish Free State Agreement) Act 1932(b)) shall come into operation on 15th March 1967.

3. Section 28(1) of the said Veterinary Surgeons Act 1966 shall not take effect to repeal section 7 of the Veterinary Surgeons Act 1948(c) until 15th November 1967 and as respects that section shall come into operation on 15th November 1967.
