## NURSES AND MIDWIVES

**The Nurses (Regional Nurse-Training Committees)  
 (Scotland) Amendment Order 1967**

<i>Made</i> - . . . . .	27th June 1967
<i>Laid before Parliament</i>	30th June 1967
<i>Coming into Operation</i>	1st July 1967

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 19(1) of and Schedule 4 to the Nurses (Scotland) Act 1951(a) and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, and after consultation with the General Nursing Council for Scotland, I hereby make the following order:—

1. This order may be cited as the Nurses (Regional Nurse-Training Committees) (Scotland) Amendment Order 1967 and shall come into operation on 1st July 1967.

2. The Interpretation Act 1889(b) applies for the interpretation of this order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. For paragraph 1 of Part III of Schedule 2 to the Nurses (Regional Nurse-Training Committees) (Scotland) Order 1963 (c) as amended (d) (which prescribes the maximum rate of payment in respect of night subsistence expenses incurred by members of Regional Nurse-Training Committees and of their Sub-Committees in the performance of their duties) there shall be substituted the following paragraph—

“1. Where a member is necessarily absent overnight from his home or place of business, on the business of the Committee or Sub-Committee, there shall be payable—

(a) an allowance not exceeding 80s. 0d. in respect of each night up to the twenty-first in one place, except that this allowance may be increased to 88s. 0d. in respect of each night spent in London within a 4-mile radius of King Charles I's statue at Charing Cross, and

(b) thereafter such allowance as the Secretary of State shall on application determine.”

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

This order increases the rate of night subsistence which may be paid to members of Regional Nurse-Training Committees and of their Sub-Committees in the performance of their duties and introduces a separate rate in respect of each night spent within a specified area in London.
