The Fees for Game and Other Licences  
(Variation) Order 1968

<i>Made</i>	- - -	25th January 1968
<i>Laid before Parliament</i>		1st February 1968
<i>Coming into Operation</i>		1st April 1968

The Treasury, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 35(2) of and Part II of Schedule 3 to the Local Government Act 1966(a) and section 42(2) of and Part II of Schedule 4 to the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1966(b), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Order:—

1. The enactments specified in the second column of the Schedule to this Order (which relate to fees payable in respect of the licences mentioned in the third column of that Schedule) shall be amended by substituting for the sums specified in the fourth column of that Schedule the sums specified in the fifth column thereof.

2. The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. This Order may be cited as the Fees for Game and Other Licences (Variation) Order 1968, and shall come into operation on 1st April 1968.
