**The Provision of Milk and Meals (Amendment No. 2)
Regulations 1968**

The Secretary of State for Education and Science, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 49 of the Education Act 1944(a) as amended by the Secretary of State for Education and Science Order 1964(b), hereby makes the following regulations:—

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Provision of Milk and Meals (Amendment No. 2) Regulations 1968 and shall come into operation on 16th August 1968.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply for the interpretation of these regulations as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Amendment of regulations

2. Regulation 14 of the Provision of Milk and Meals Regulations 1945(d) as amended (e) shall cease to have effect in so far as it enables a local education authority to require a teacher to supervise pupils during school meals and accordingly there shall be omitted—

(a) in regulation 13(2)(b) the words “having regard to the power given to the Authority by the next following regulation to require teachers to supervise pupils”; and

(b) in regulation 14 everything after the word “meals” where that word first occurs.
